THE SELLER AGREES TO SELL AND DELIVER WATER TO THE CUSTOMER AND THE CUSTOMER AGREES TO PURCHASE AND RECEIVE WATER FROM THE UTILITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE UTILITY AS INCLUDED IN ITS APPROVED TARIFF ON FILE WITH THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN CITY AND THE TCEQ.

ALL WATER WILL BE MEASURED BY METERS WHICH ARE FURNISHED, INSTALLED, OWNED AND MAINTAINED BY THE UTILITY. THE METER AND CONNECTION IS FOR THE SOLE USE OF THE CUSTOMER TO SERVE WATER TO ONE DWELLING, BUSINESS PROPERTY, ETC. THE CUSTOMER SHALL NOT SHARE, RESELL, OR SUB-METER TO ANY OTHER DWELLING, BUSINESS PROPERTY, ETC., WITHOUT THE SPECIFIC WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION OF THE UTILITY AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS AND REGULATIONS.

THE UTILITY HAS THE RIGHT TO LOCATE A WATER SERVICE METER AND THE PIPE NECESSARY TO CONNECT THE METER ON THE PROPERTY OF THE CUSTOMER AT A POINT MUTUALLY AGREEABLE TO BOTH THE UTILITY AND THE CUSTOMER. THE CUSTOMER WILL ALLOW THE UTILITY ACCESS AT ALL REASONABLE TIMES TO IT'S PROPERTY AND EQUIPMENT LOCATED ON THE CUSTOMER'S PROPERTY FOR THE LIMITED PURPOSES OF READING THE WATER METER, REPAIRING OR REPLACING EXISTING FACILITIES AND THE INSPECTION OF CUSTOMER'S FACILITIES TO CHECK FOR ILLEGAL CONNECTIONS OR UNSAFE PLUMBING PRACTICES, OR CROSS-CONNECTIONS, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AND IT'S "RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS.

There is a \$ .20 per 1000 gallon charge from Barton Springs Edwards Aquifer Conservation District (BSEACD) that will be itemized on each customer's account. This fee is subject to change by the BSEACD and automatically passed through to customers.

Rules for regulating the installation of Yard irrigation systems (Sprinkler Systems) in Mountain City, TX

1. A permit must be obtained from Mountain City Water System prior to the installation of the yard irrigation system (No cost for permit).
2. All of the standards as outlined in Chapter 34 of the Texas Water Code, Title 30, and Chapter 344, "Rules for Licensed irrigators/Licensed installers" must be complied with.
3. The system must be inspected by a representative of Mountain City Water Utility prior to the covering of the lines from meter to backflow prevention device.
4. The irrigation system may not be used prior to or until we have a Backflow inspection Report on file in the Mountain City office. Violations will necessitate termination of water service until compliance with rules is adhered to.
5. All backflow devices must be located within three (3) feet of the water meter that supplies water to the property.
6. The connection between the water meter and the Backflow Prevention Device must be Schedule 40 PVC pipe and a shut off valve must be installed between the Backflow Prevention Device and the water meter that supplies water to the irrigation system.
7. To be in compliance with TCEQ rules, Mountain city Water Utility will be unable to supply water to any customer who does not comply with the above mentioned rules.
8. Backflow Prevention Device Maintenance Report must be a Mountain City Water Utility S form. Contact the office for a copy of the form.
